IGF 2022 MAG Meeting VII | 14 June 2022 Summary report

Action items

Workshop evaluation process

- MAG members to complete the evaluation of workshop proposals until Wednesday 29
 June 2022, 23:59 UTC. No extension will be granted.
- 1. The seventh virtual meeting of the Internet Governance Forum (IGF) Multistakeholder Advisory Group (MAG) in the IGF 2022 preparatory cycle was held on 14 June 2022 and was moderated by Mr. Paul Mitchell, MAG Chair.

Attached to this summary report are the meeting agenda (Annex I) and the list of participants (Annex II).

I. Updates from IGF Secretariat

2. The IGF 2022 youth track will be launched at the EuroDIG meeting (to be held on 20–22 June) with a workshop prepared by youth IGF coordinators, the IGF Secretariat, and the IGF 2022 host country. The Secretariat will also host a capacity development session on the margins of EuroDIG. MAG members are invited to join both sessions, either in situ or online.

II. IGF 2022 workshop proposals

- 3. The Secretariat provided some statistics on the IGF 2022 call for workshops:
 - In total, 245 workshop proposals are to be evaluated by the MAG (compared with 203 in 2021).
 - Most proposals are for roundtables and 90-minute sessions.
 - 580 co-organizers listed in organizing teams of 245 workshops. Among them, 113 are involved in more than one workshop about 20 % while 467 are involved in only one workshop (unique organizer).
 - 802 stakeholders proposed as speakers for the 245 workshops. 92 speakers appear in more than one workshop a little more than 10% while 710 appear only in one workshop.
 - Most proposals were submitted under the theme Connecting all people and safeguarding human rights (88), followed by Enabling safety, security and accountability (49), Addressing advanced technologies, including AI (46), Governing data and protecting privacy (41), and Avoiding Internet fragmentation (21).
- 4. MAG members were reminded of the following issues regarding the workshop evaluation process:
 - The MAG has approximately two weeks to complete the evaluations, until **Wednesday 29 June 2022, 23:59 UTC**.
 - The Secretariat will compile evaluation data before the Second Open Consultations and MAG Meeting (6-8 July). The aim is to share this data with the MAG by **4 July**.

- Because of the tight timeline, no extensions can be given on the deadline for evaluation.
- The MAG has been divided into 5 randomized evaluating groups of 8 people, following the
 themes as much as possible, while equitably distributing the proposals (approximately 50-60 per
 group). To the extent possible, some thought has also been given to making the groups diverse
 in terms of gender, stakeholder group and region. These are the group assignments:

- It is the responsibility of every MAG member to complete evaluations. The Secretariat keeps an internal record of who has done so and may impact a MAG members renewal.
