REPORT



Introduction

The Internet Governance Forum (IGF) was created in 2006 in response to the United Nations' request for discussions on internet governance. This initiative was launched with the aim of creating a space for exchange and conversation where governments, businesses, civil society, academics, and individuals could come together to discuss internet governance. The IGF is a unique model of multistakeholder internet governance that brings together different stakeholders with a common goal: to study internet issues and propose solutions to the problems related to its development. The Youth IGF, on the other hand, is an initiative born out of the desire of Beninese youth to learn and ensure high-quality succession in terms of organization, training, and inclusion related to the internet and its governance. It provides an opportunity for young people to share their perspectives, ideas, and concerns on internet issues and interact with key stakeholders. It is in this context that the first edition of the Youth Internet Governance Forum in Benin was organized on Saturday, May 20, 2023, in Abomey-Calavi, Benin.

This initiative was launched with the aim of providing young people with a space for exchange and discussion on internet governance issues. This event brought together young people from various backgrounds to discuss the challenges and issues related to this field in Benin. Students, the academic community, young people from the public and private sectors, civil society, the youth parliament, and others represented the diversity of participants. This report will present the objectives of this first edition of the Youth IGF, recall the expected results of the work, present the overall process of its implementation, and conclude with the results obtained and the recommendations made by the participants.

I. OBJECTIVES

Main Objective: Contribute to the establishment and sustainable maintenance of a trusted and secure cyberspace for more opportunities for young people.

Specific objectives: More specifically, the objectives of this forum are:

- Make the terminologies related to cybersecurity and digital trust explicit and accessible to the
 participants for their informed engagement in secure governance.
- Understand the efforts of stakeholders, particularly the government and the private sector, regarding cybersecurity and digital trust solutions implemented in Benin, and the results achieved so far.
- Promote digital literacy among young internet users, based on the existing legal and regulatory framework in Benin in this regard.

• Develop digital inclusion among young people to better equip them to work towards bridging the digital divide in Benin.

II. EXPECTED RESULTS

At the end of this youth forum, the following results were expected:

- Clarify the terminologies related to cybersecurity and digital trust for informed engagement in secure governance.
- Evaluate the efforts of the government and the private sector regarding cybersecurity and digital trust solutions in Benin, as well as the results achieved.
- Utilize their knowledge of digital literacy to adopt best practices for secure internet use.
- Make proposals to help bridge the digital divide in Benin.

III. OVERALL PROCESS

Benin organized its first youth forum this year based on the fundamental principles of openness, transparency, inclusivity, bottom-up decision-making, non-commerciality, and multi-stakeholderism. The overall process consisted of three main phases: the preparatory phase, the actual event, and the post-session phase. All tasks of this process were carried out by an adhoc organizing committee established by the group of young people initiating the event.

1. Preparatory Phase

The preparatory phase involved the following activities:

- Formation of the Organizing Committee composed of young volunteers,
- Drafting of terms of reference,
- Identification of potential sponsors and partners, communicators, and young people from various stakeholders (public sector, private sector, civil society, technical community),
- Sending emails and physical letters,
- Production of working documents,
- Identification of service providers (catering, internet, broadcasting equipment),
- Preparation of the draft of the final communiqué and thank you letters, etc.

2. The actual forum

It was marked by the following phases: opening ceremony, session discussions, and reading and amendment of the final communiqué.

• Opening Ceremony

It included three speeches: one by the Vice-President of Youth IGF Benin, Ms. Funmilayo KINDONOU, one by Ms. Anja GENGO from IGF secretariat, and one by the President of the National Internet Governance Forum, Mr. Wilfried Quenum. The first speaker, after welcoming the participants, emphasized the importance of this forum as a space for collaboration between young people and between these young people and different actors to develop solutions and implement effective policies to ensure a safe, secure, and inclusive cyberspace for all. Wilfred Quenum and the representative from IGF secretariat praised the organizing committee of this first edition of the Youth National Internet Governance Forum, encouraged the initiative, and provided some advice to the organizers and participants. The official opening of the forum was conducted by the President of IGF Benin.

Sessions

Type of sessions: the forum was held in a hybrid mode, i.e both in person and online.

Speakers and session summaries

Summary of Session 1: Cybersecurity, digital trust, and related lexicon: clarification of terminologies.



Speaker: Miss **Fydias SAGBOHAN** (Foundation of Young Amazons for Development FJAD-NGO / Global Youth Network Benin)

She clarified the key concepts related to cybersecurity and digital trust. In the introduction, she highlighted that the COVID-19 pandemic has led to a significant increase in internet activity due to the development

of online learning, the need to stay in touch with family, the need for access to online information, etc. After explaining the concepts of cybersecurity, digital trust, and some related terminologies, she presented the challenges of digital trust.

Summary of Session 2: Importance of data.

Speaker: Mr. **Elyes Grar** (Digital Strategy Expert and Enterprise Architect with a focus on the public sector, with over 25 years of experience in IT strategy).

His presentation focused on the importance of data, particularly in Africa in the age of data. He presented the evolution of information sharing from ancient times to the present day, explained the data flow between government, businesses, and citizens, and discussed data management tools and the significance of data for Africa.



Summary of Session 3: Cybersecurity and digital trust solutions implemented in Benin and their results.

Speaker: **Yalekpon N. HOUNGNIHIN** (Executive Director of Women Be Free NGO).

According to him, the foundations of cybersecurity are prevention, threat detection, and response capability. It is important to protect oneself when using digital tools. Protection involves being vigilant during online payments, exercising caution when using smartphones and tablets, regularly updating software and applications, choosing strong passwords, and more. The structures responsible for digital security were also presented to the participants. These include the ASIN (Agency for Information Systems and Digital) and the OCRC (Central Office for the Suppression of Cybercrime). The government has undertaken several actions to make the cyberspace a safe space, including the establishment of the digital code, training sessions, and awareness campaigns, among others.



Furthermore, the speaker presented the results achieved through the implementation of cybersecurity and digital trust solutions. As a result, Benin made a leap of 69 places in the 2018 Global Cybersecurity Index ranking. This composite index analyzes states' commitment to cybersecurity and their population's awareness in this regard. The country is ranked 56th out of 194 countries in the latest report of the Global Cybersecurity Index published on June 29, 2021, by the International Telecommunication Union

(ITU). In comparison to this index, the country has moved up 92 places between 2017 and 2020, from 149th in 2017 to 80th in 2018 and finally 56th in 2020. On a continental scale, Benin went from 33rd place in 2017 to 8th place in 2018 and 6th out of the 44 evaluated African countries in 2020.

Summary of Session 4: Promoting digital literacy among young internet users: tools and strategies.



Speaker: MOUSSA Akim (National Assembly of Benin). Mr. Akim discussed the concept of digital literacy among young internet users. He emphasized that the internet is a lawless zone, and it is crucial to educate young people about responsible use of digital technology. This is where digital literacy promotion comes into play. He presented

the legal framework in Benin and the tools for promoting digital literacy, including educational programs, online media and resources, awareness campaigns, and partnerships. Questions were raised, including how to make the internet available to children and the involvement of young people in promoting digital literacy. It is important to educate and raise awareness among parents about digital literacy so that they can protect their children from the negative aspects of the internet. Parents should equip themselves to constantly monitor their children's online activities. Additionally, digital services should incorporate educational programs and be tailored to different user categories. Young people need to learn how to evaluate online information, recognize reliable sources, especially in a world driven by rapid advances in known and unknown AI technologies, and how to be respectful and responsible in using the internet.

Summary of Session 5: Comprehensive digital inclusion in Benin: bridging the gap.

Speaker: Mr. Tinos Noé ANAGO (GreenIT Innovator & Founder of NerdX Digital)

He started by introducing the concept of digital inclusion and its importance. For him, it is essential to ensure that no one is left behind (elderly people, poor households, rural residents, people with disabilities, etc.). Several barriers hinder digital inclusion, including limited access to infrastructure, low digital literacy, high costs of devices and services, language and cultural barriers, lack of awareness



and trust, etc. The presenter provided some solutions, such as improving internet accessibility, enhancing digital skills among users, reducing costs, promoting more inclusive content, and raising awareness...

3. Post-session phase

This phase is dedicated to the drafting of the final communiqué, the forum report, its translation into English, thank-you letters, etc.

IV. ACHIEVED RESULTS

The 1st Youth Forum on Internet Governance in Benin has yielded the following results:

- Clarification of terminologies related to cybersecurity and digital trust, providing participants with an informed understanding of their engagement in the cyberspace.
- Knowledge of cybersecurity and digital trust solutions in Benin and their results, with
- participants directed towards the ecosystem of internet-related structures in Benin to seek
 - assistance in case of cyber threats.
- Understanding the importance of digital literacy and adoption of good practices for secure
 - internet use.
- Development of relevant proposals for various stakeholders.

V. PARTICIPATION

Participation was as follows:

- > Online participation : 35,
- > In-person participation : 26.

VI. RECOMMENDATIONS

At the end of the proceedings, the participating stakeholders made recommendations. These recommendations are addressed to several factors, including the government and public administration, the private sector, mobile operators, internet service providers, and internet service providers. The recommendations can be summarized as follows:

- Strengthen awareness of data security.
- Develop awareness and training programs on best practices in data security.
- Encourage the development and implementation of strategies to bridge the digital divide.
- Promote digital literacy among young people, especially through formal and non-formal education.
- Encourage partnerships between different stakeholders (government, private sector, civil society, academia, technical community, etc.) for effective and inclusive internet governance.
- Develop strategies to improve internet accessibility, especially in rural and underserved areas.

• Establish mechanisms to ensure the sustainability of the Youth Internet Governance Forum in Benin.

VII. OUR SPONSORS

For the organization of this first edition of the National Youth Forum on Internet Governance, the organizing committee received technical support from Women Be Free, an NGO specialized in internet governance issues. As of the writing of this report, the organizing committee has only received confirmation of support in the amount of \$1500 from IGFSA. ISOC Benin was expected to receive requested funds to support the forum. The Youth IGF Benin organizing committee is still awaiting this support in order to settle payments to service providers.


