**MAG Working Group on Workshops Process (WG-WSP) Meeting III**

**Action items & next steps**

The meeting was co-chaired by MAG Members Peace Oliver Amuge and Lito Ibarra, with support from the Secretariat. The following participated: MAG Members Chris Buckridge, Amrita Choudhury, Bram Fudzulani, Vadim Gluschenko, Adam Peake and Alan Ramírez García; and former MAG Members Juliana Harsianti and June Parris.

**1. Review of Clean Workshop Form**

- The Working Group did a final review of the draft workshop form, now in “clean” format with all comments and edits from the group incorporated.

**Actions**

- ➔ **An introductory paragraph drafted at the top of the form by Chris Buckridge was approved by the group.**
- ➔ **It was agreed to emphasise the issues of diversity (along various vectors, such as gender and region, within co-organising teams and speaking panels) and the hybrid nature of the proposals. While “Diversity” as a form section had been removed, the intro paragraph underlines its importance. Both diversity and holding a hybrid session were highlighted for discussing in MAG plenary.**
- ➔ **It was also agreed to further discuss in MAG plenary the question of whether or not to anonymise proposers’ information during evaluation.**

**2. Workshop Evaluation Criteria**

- The Working Group gave initial consideration to the evaluation criteria applied last year and shared in an editable document by the Secretariat.

**Actions**

- ➔ **The WG agreed it would continue to consider these after the meeting in Vienna and following the approval of the form.**
