1. How would you describe your participation at the IGF meeting? (max. 150 words)

Participation at the IGF / Berlin 2019 was very beneficial. Even before the event, I could tell you that I had done my own program, I had to rearrange it to include other view the importance of the topics covered.

I took part in giving my opinion in a certain session but most of my participation was to identify the contours of the operation of this platform on the governance of the Internet issue to benefit from a feedback experience in my country.

The report was bitter during the parliamentary session of the IGF 2019 where no Burkinabe parliamentarian made the trip to Berlin. Then I intend to participate in the various national and regional initiatives of the country and to set up the "YOUTH IGF / Burkina" by the next IGF.

Meetings such as networking have flourished with internet governance actors from Africa and elsewhere. I participated in fundraising meetings (IGFSA). Knowing how the IGF works has been of great interest to me. One thing is to be supported but knowing the mechanism of financing Initiatives is an asset to better manage the funds that can be made available. During the meeting, it was decided to set up an ecommerce platform with some participants to support vulnerable groups for the employability of out-of-school girls in difficult situations.
