SUMMARY REPORT

Action Items

- IGF Secretariat to create a survey form to collect inputs on the policy focus of the main session.
- NRIs to meet again to finalize the main session based on the form's inputs (12 July at 13 UTC).

About

1. The seventh virtual meeting of the National, Sub-regional, Regional and Youth IGF Initiatives (NRIs) of the IGF 2022 preparatory cycle, took place on 28 June 2022 at 14:00 UTC. For the first time, this meeting was transcribed live.¹
2. The meeting was hosted by the IGF Secretariat's NRIs Focal Point. The final, adopted version of the Agenda is attached to this document as Annex A1 and a list of meeting participants as Annex A2. The list of shared documents is annexed as A3.

Summary of key points

3. The Host opened the meeting by reminding everyone that the objective of the meeting is to continue planning the NRIs main sessions.
4. The Host invited for comments on the current main session draft proposal, focusing on the policy questions.
5. All shared comments were live captured in the working document available on this [link](#)² (A3). In summary, participants shared the principles related to the trusted Internet which could be discussed during the main session. Given the complexity of the issues shared and the time limitation of this call, it was agreed that the NRIs focal point will create a survey through which all NRIs can input ideas for the main session policy questions. It was agreed to host an ad-hoc meeting just on this on 12 July at 14 UTC.
6. Due to lack of time, other updates planned as per the agenda, will be shared via NRIs mailing list.
