SUMMARY REPORT

Action Items:

About

- 1. The tenth virtual meeting of the National, Sub-regional, Regional and Youth IGF Initiatives (NRIs) of the IGF 2022 preparatory cycle, took place on 7 November 2022 at 14:00 UTC.
- 2. The meeting was hosted by the IGF Secretariat's NRIs Focal Point. The final, adopted version of the Agenda is attached to this document as Annex A1 and a list of meeting participants as Annex A2. The list of shared documents is annexed as A3.

- 8. Tentative plan: host the session on 28 November at 13-14 hrs Addis Ababa time in room Banquet Hall B (250+ seats). Anja will confirm the exact time and location and send calendar invite.
- 9. The 60-min agenda could focus on:
 - 1. 1. Sustainability of NRIs (sharing practices from different aspects such as capacity development (SIGs), youth, financing)
 - 2. 2. Way forward (Contributing to Global Digital Compact; Strategic approach to WSIS+20 review)
- 10. NRIs to advise if guest speakers need to be invited and who. MAG Chair, DESA and IGF Secretariat will traditionally attend.
- 11. NRIs Focal Point to share the invitation to the DC-SIG session where NRIs can contribute with their practices and ask questions.
