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Who we are

Established in 2007, the Internet Governance Forum Spain (IGF Spain) is an open and decentralized space that aims to foster the debate of public policy issues relating to the Internet. It draws inspiration from the Internet Governance Forum (IGF), established by the United Nations Secretary General in 2006. The IGF Spain is chaired by Prof. Jorge Pérez Martínez and provides a multistakeholder platform that brings together people from various stakeholder groups on equal footing (representatives of the civil society, government, the private sector, the academia, and the technical community). It is meant to elevate the voice of the Spanish society to the international fora of internet governance.

The funding of the IGF Spain comes from the corporate sponsorships of Fundación Telefónica, Fundación Vodafone, Google and Orange, and in-kind collaboration of other entities, such as the Universidad Politécnica de Madrid¹ (UPM) and the Secretary of State for Telecommunication and Digital Infrastructures.

Structure

The IGF Spain is supported by a Multistakeholder Advisory Group, whose members belong to different organizations within the government, the private sector, the civil society, and the technical and academic communities.

The Multistakeholder Advisory Group is open to anyone willing to engage in the activities of the forum. Other entities, such as civil society (Asociación de Internautas, Anei, Cibercotizante, Cibervoluntarios and Asociación de usuarios de Internet) and corporate associations (Ametic and Digitales), are also engaged in the working groups and help to distribute the messages of the forum. The Multistakeholder Advisory Group holds regular meetings throughout the year.

The Multistakeholder Group select the topics and helps define the working groups, which are in charge of finding the panelists and the focus of the debate.

Youth IGF

The Youth IGF Spain aims to be a multidisciplinary space for dialogue where all the young people in Spain can share their vision and expectations about the future of the Internet. It was created on September 2022, and so far has 22 members from different disciplines, including telecommunications and public relations.

So far, we have had different activities to promote the initiative:

1. Competition to create the poster and motto of the IGF Spain 2022
2. Competition sponsored by the association DigitalEs under the theme: “Normalization, standardization, and regulation of disruptive technologies: the challenge of balancing business, rights and innovation”, with Artificial Intelligence as the chosen technology. The prize was a trip to attend the European Dialogue on Internet Governance in Tampere, Finland.
The competition was structured in two phases, the first where the participants had to write an essay, which were later judged by our sponsor and by the IGF Spain. The four bests were selected for a debate which took place on the 15th of November, the day dedicated to the presentation of the Youth IGF Spain.
3. Youth IGF Spain day: On the 15th of November, the Youth IGF Spain was officially presented, with the participation of DigitalEs. We had a participation of 43 people with 25 being students ranging from ages 18 to 30.



Annual meeting preparation

Working groups

The Spanish IGF annual meeting 2022 is a three-day hybrid event (face-to-face and online) held at Polytechnical University of Madrid with different sessions in a structured program with several roundtables. All the talks had the aim to cover the most relevant and interesting issues in the field of internet governance. These sessions were organized by the working groups, which are built annually at the beginning of the year to work in the organization of the annual event.

The members of each working group are representatives of different stakeholder groups: public sector, private sector, academy, and civil society represented in different NGOs.

Communication & Dissemination

The Secretariat designed and implemented a strategic plan for the general communication of the event. It was worked in five lines:

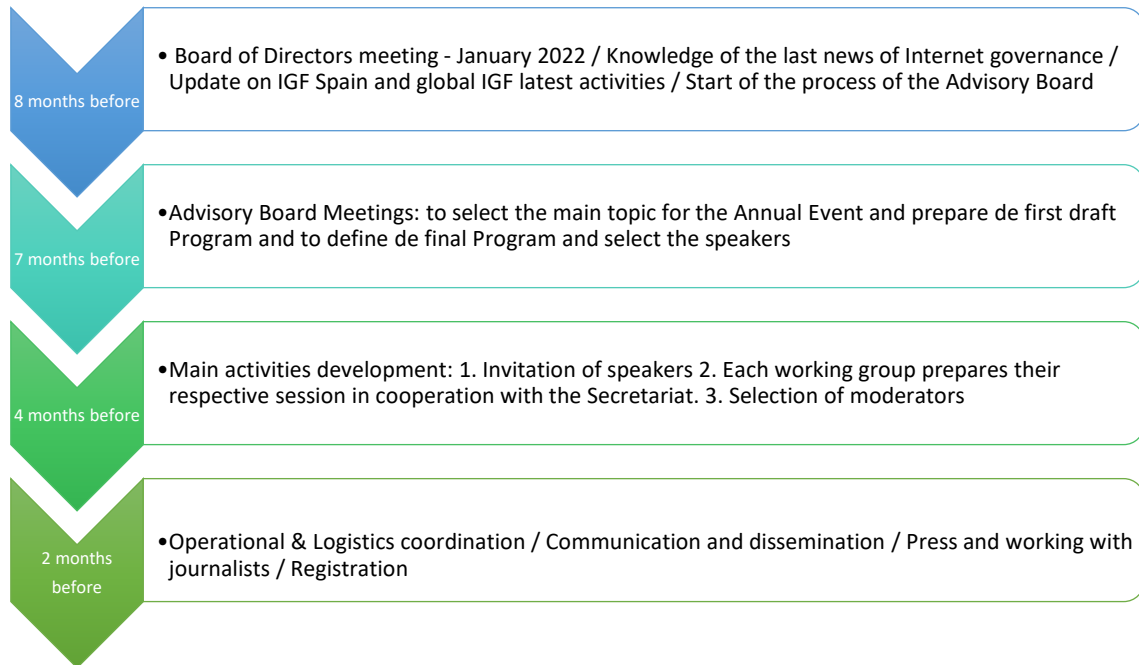
- Contact and articulation with the experts and exhibitors for the different presentations and for the main conferences.
- Dissemination to favor the participation in the event.
- Contact with organizations from the human and social field to amplify the discussion and the interaction.
- Articulation with press and journalists to amplify the presence in the mass media and to prepare the management of roundtables for the event day.
- Increase the presence in social networks.

The Secretariat, as every year, develops an annual action plan for the social networks and for the website (www.igfspain.org) to keep the community informed and engaged. The content of the IGF Spain 2022 was the result from the participation of the Secretariat in the NRIs strategic group and was oriented from the central topic of the Global IGF 2022.

Session 1. Towards Co-Regulation or Co-Governance of the Internet?

On April 28, 2022, the US, the European Union and 32 other countries approved a Declaration on the Future of the Internet, which is committed to a governance system that has all 'stakeholders'. The Digital Services Act (DSA), approved in July, provides for self-regulatory and co-regulatory agreements and the creation of out-of-court dispute resolution bodies. In addition, both the Audiovisual Media Services Directive and the Intellectual Property Directive in the Digital Single Market (and Spanish transposition laws) provide for self-regulation and co-regulation mechanisms.

What will these mechanisms or bodies of co-regulation or co-governance of the internet look like? What role do they have between the internal mechanisms of companies and administrative regulation?

Session 2. Digital sovereignty and Internet fragmentation.

The fragmentation of the Internet has been a reality that has been of concern to the different stakeholders involved in Internet governance for years. While technical and commercial fragmentation needs to be addressed, in which the functioning of the Internet is affected by a combination of voluntary and involuntary business conditions and practices, the fragmentation of government policy that limits Internet uses or affects the open and interoperable nature of the Internet is a growing concern in the new geopolitical context. What are the main threats to today's single, open, free and interoperable Internet? Is there a real risk of split-internet appearing? How can we avoid the fragmentation of the Internet when countries claim their digital sovereignty? Is Europe contributing to the fragmentation of the Internet with its regulations? What is the vision from Spain?

Session 3. Debate: The contribution of OTTs to the financing of European telecommunications infrastructures.

Thierry Breton, the EU Internal Market Commissioner, has announced his intention to hold a public consultation in the first quarter of 2023 on whether or not large US technology companies are eligible to contribute to the financing of European telecoms and internet infrastructures. The announcement has generated a great controversy with taking very

different and passionate positions. No one can hide the impact that this measure would have on the European digital ecosystem. In this session, the Internet Governance Forum organizes one of the first debates in Spain on this topic.

Session 4. From Internet vulnerabilities to hybrid conflict and cybercrime.

Who is responsible for fixing the Internet? When a new vulnerability is discovered in a service or platform used by thousands or even millions of users, how should it be acted, to whom is it informed? How and when is it communicated to users who are exposed? What obligations and deadlines exist to fix this new vulnerability? Who ensures that they are complied with?

It should not be forgotten that governments, intelligence agencies, private companies, pressure groups and mafias buy these vulnerabilities and exploit them within hybrid conflicts or to commit cybercrimes. We have recent examples in the invasion of Ukraine, the Pegasus case or the latest ransomware families that have affected many public bodies, companies or individuals thanks to the Crime as a Service model.

This table will address this panorama from different points of view, delving into how adequate Internet governance in this regard, the publication and resolution of vulnerabilities, can result in greater security for all Internet users. And pointing out the challenges that this poses in the future given the current context of hybrid conflicts and the explosion of cybercrime.

Session 5. Challenges and opportunities of the metaverse: Breakthrough or turning point?

The metaverse, or metaverses, is nothing new, but it is topical. Since last year the searches for the word "metaverse" multiplied by more than a hundred, media coverage has grown on a reality like this that, however, has many aspects to take into account. Not only the economic dimension, both for the growth opportunities it offers, as well as for the challenges it can pose in who dominates the market or the role of SMEs – more in a country like Spain. The metaverse also has an intrinsic relationship with regulation and rights.

With this in mind, this session aims to be a first space for open reflection on the different perspectives that exist on the metaverse. First, do we need to regulate the metaverse? And, if so, how: a new regulation, or based on existing ones? Second, in terms of rights, ethics are already beginning to be discussed in the metaverse, with cases such as the privacy of personal data or virtual harassment. How can we move on to talking about rights, and not just ethical principles?

Participation in the annual meeting

The 2022 Spain annual meeting has chosen a hybrid format. It has reached 339 registered participants (158 for online participation and 182 for face-to-face).

The total number of speakers where 42. These speakers represent well all the sectors of the Internet stakeholders in Spain. The participation included representatives from the Spanish government and public institutions:

Course on Governance of the Digital and Internet Ecosystem

An online course has been organized from October 17 to 27, 2022 in collaboration with the Polytechnic University of Madrid that grants an official degree to those students who pass the exam.

The objective of the course is to provide a holistic vision of the digital ecosystem and the Internet that allows students to acquire updated knowledge about their governance, the agents involved, the context in which they move and the European and Spanish regulations that affect them.

The course is aimed at undergraduate, master's and doctoral students of any degree related to technologies, as well as professionals, who wish to acquire knowledge about the Governance of the Digital Ecosystem and the Internet.

This edition of the course was attended by 11 students with the following profiles:

- 3 undergraduate or master's degree students in engineering
- 1 Professional Law Graduate
- 1 professional degree in Economics
- 1 Professional Bachelor of International Relations
- 5 professional ICT engineers

There are students from Latin American universities (Bolivia, Argentina, Mexico), the European Commission and several Spanish companies.

The course consists of 15 topics structured in 5 modules and a complementary activity of assistance to the IGF Spain Annual Meeting. The following is the course program.

3.3. Regulation of trust and security in telecommunication networks. 5G cybersecurity law.

4.1 Social Media Governance. Digital rights in the Digital Services Regulation (DSA).

4.2 Regulation of platforms in the Digital Markets Regulation (DMA).

4.3 Artificial Intelligence: can you put doors to the field?

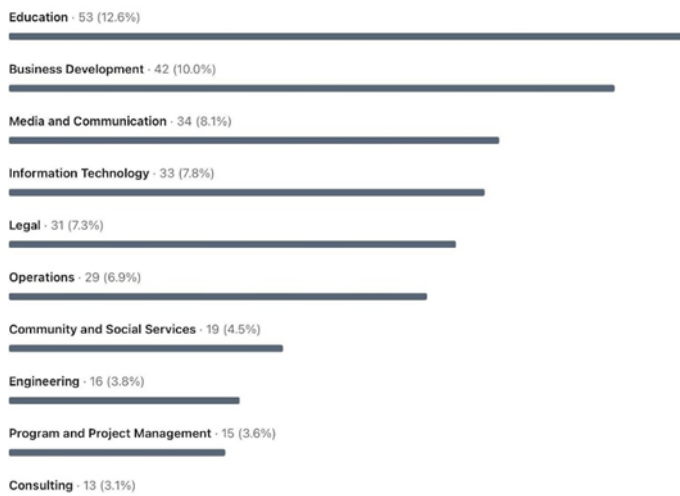
