WORK PLAN

Goals

- In-depth look at why achieving meaningful and universal Internet access remains so challenging, despite years of efforts by policy makers and other actors from all stakeholder groups
- Assess and gather good practices and policy recommendations already discussed at the IGF
- Identify what the key barriers are to these not being implemented
- Facilitate networking among actors from all stakeholder groups that are concerned with the topic

2022 Focus Areas

Three overarching thematic workstreams building up on last year's work:

- Connectivity (infrastructure and business models, analysed within the framework of the Roadmap for Digital Cooperation)
- Digital Inclusion (accessibility and multilingualism), with special attention to local contents in local languages, helping the digital transition of existing experiences
- Capacity Development (technical skills training)

WORK PLAN

Methodology

- Identify, map and understand the properties that those operating in the field identified as key to meaningful access
- Shed light on the reasons why known, effective policy solutions currently lack scaling in their implementation
- Analyse focus areas by asking questions on gaps on policy, connectivity, digital inclusion, civic engagement and intersectionality
- Close attention to good practices on multilingualism/content in local languages

Planned Outputs

- Informative and action-oriented report: collaborative, multistakeholder work towards our goals
- Permanent repository of positive and successful experiences on meaningful access
- Outreach and engagement activities: building bridges
