# CALL FOR INPUTS ON GOOD PRACTICES

## 2022 PNMA Goals

- In-depth look at why achieving meaningful and universal Internet access remains so challenging, despite years of efforts by policy makers and other actors from all stakeholder groups
- Assess and gather good practices and policy recommendations already discussed at the IGF
- Identify what the key barriers are to these not being implemented
- Facilitate networking among actors from all stakeholder groups that are concerned with the topic

## Call for Inputs

- The PNMA MWG invites its community and any interested stakeholder to **share stories, case studies, local experiences, and successfully implemented practices** under this year's three focus areas:
  - Connectivity (infrastructure and business models, analysed within the framework of the Roadmap for Digital Cooperation)
  - Digital Inclusion (accessibility and multilingualism), with special attention to local contents in local languages, helping the digital transition of existing experiences
  - Capacity Development (technical skills training)

# CALL FOR INPUTS ON GOOD PRACTICES

## General guidelines

- The PNMA is especially interested in gathering successful cases of good practices on multilingualism/content in local language and innovative examples of use of digital tools in order to improve life conditions of the users
- Submissions can refer to **newly established, ongoing, or previous projects**, showcasing what works in their approach, what has not worked, and lessons learned from the experience.
- MWG can identify whether policy actions have facilitated or encouraged increased meaningful access
- Submissions via survey and supporting documentation until **18 September 2022 18:00 UTC**
- Selected cases will be featured in the policy network's 2022 output report.
- All complete and appreciated submissions will be added to a forthcoming PNMA's repository of good practices which will be made available on our webpage

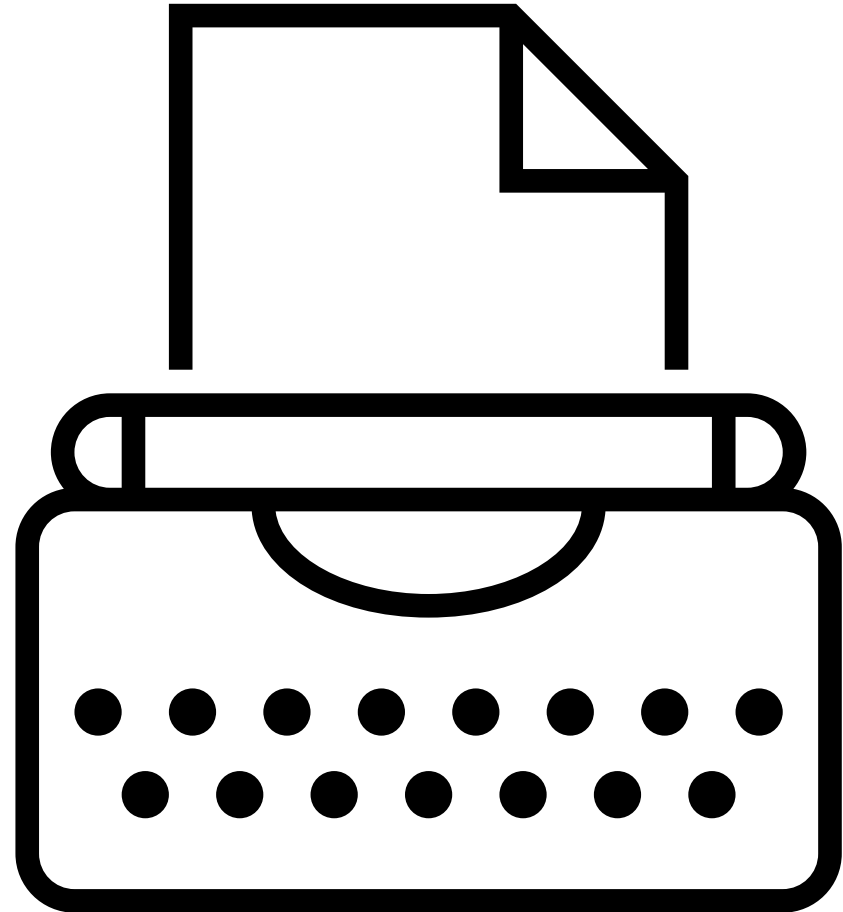
