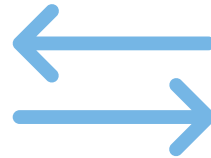


This is just the first draft. We can continue to work on it during the feedback phase and incorporate elements of the Main Session into the final version to be published in December.

24 November: IGF deadline on draft for the annual meeting

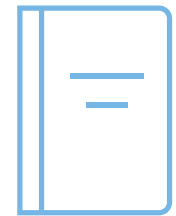
