**Meeting III | 4 July 2023 at 14:00-15:30 UTC**

**SUMMARY REPORT**

**Action items:**

1. The second virtual meeting of the Policy Network on Artificial Intelligence (PNAI) took place on 4 July 2023 at 14:00-15:30 UTC.
2. The meeting was hosted by the IGF Secretariat's PNAI Consultant and the two MAG facilitators of the PNAI. The final version of the Agenda is attached to this document as Annex A1 and a list of meeting participants as Annex A2. The list of shared documents is annexed as A3.
3. The hosts opened the meeting and offered a brief recap on the PNAI progress in its first two months. The main deliverables include the workplan and the report outline. Three drafting teams have been formed, two PNAI meetings held and the mailing list currently reaches 183 subscribers.
4. The timeline for preparing the PNAI report in time for the 18th annual meeting of the IGF in October 2023 was discussed. The work of drafting teams should be finalized by September 7th, a consultation is planned to take place between 12th and 19th September and the report would be ready on 21st September. The timeline is tight and requires careful planning.
5. The three drafting teams ('Environment and AI', 'Global interoperability of AI governance', and 'AI and gender / race') offered brief updates on their status. All three have held or scheduled their first meetings. Those interested can still sign up to join the teams.
6. Prateek Sibal and Gustavo Gustavo Fonseca Ribeiro from UNESCO presented on Interoperability and AI Governance. The presentation offered insight on the scope, stakeholders and influences of AI governance, and suggested challenges and recommendations, including multistakeholderism in standard-setting and capacity building. The attendees asked questions and offered their view on the topic.



7. Dr. Stuart Armstrong and Rebecca Gorman from Aligned AI presented on measuring and removing bias in AI. Concrete examples clarified the meaning of bias and offered examples of removing bias from texts generated by AI. The co-founders recommended that policymakers consider whether de-biasing should be required. Active discussion between the two co-founders and the meeting attendees followed the presentation.
8. PNAI will plan a session for the 18th annual meeting of the IGF in October 2023. A document to gather ideas on the concept and speakers will be circulated after the meeting. It is important to learn about other AI-themed sessions that are under preparation. PNAI will also present on achievements in the first two months of the work in the IGF 2023 Second Open Consultations on July 10th-12th.

10. All attendees were asked to share their ideas and views on the PNAI session to be prepared for the 18th annual meeting of the IGF in October 2023.
