Meeting IV in 2025 | 30 July 2025 at 13:00-14:00 UTC

SUMMARY REPORT

Action items:

- Deadline for Key Messages and International AI Fora projects is **1.9**. Working teams will finalize their work, convene as needed and share the documents through PNAI mailing list for final comments.
- All PNAI members are encouraged to answer PNAI survey by **15.9**.
- September PNAI MWG meeting will be a discussion on the first two PNAI Policy Brief topics. Invites will be sent out soon. The starting point text will be prepared based on input that has been gathered so far and circulated through PNAI mailing list one week prior.

1. The fourth virtual meeting in 2025 of the Policy Network on Artificial Intelligence (PNAI) Multistakeholder Working Group (MWG) took place online on 30 July 2025 at 13:00 UTC.
2. The meeting was hosted by the three MAG facilitators and coordinators of the PNAI, Amrita Choudhury, Audace Niyonkuru, Xiao Zhang, and Maikki Sipinen. The final version of the Agenda is attached to this document as Annex A1 and a list of meeting participants as Annex A2. The list of shared documents is annexed as A3.
3. The hosts opened the call, the first item on the meeting agenda was an update on latest developments. PNAI Main Session at IGF 2025 report is now available online, prepared by a rapporteur team led by Sana Nisar. Two PNAI projects are making process: PNAI Key Messages and List of International AI Fora. WSIS+20 process is in the forefront, the elements paper has a section on AI.
4. The main goal of the meeting was to agree on a workplan and process for preparing PNAI Policy Brief 2025. The report will deliver suggestions on maximizing IGF/PNAI impact as the central platform for multistakeholder discussions on AI governance.
 - Input gathering has been going on since June through the Main Session at IGF and an interactive webinar. The online survey will stay open until 15.9. All PNAI members are encouraged to answer the survey and are welcome to share it with others. Judith Hellerstein will share it with DCs and NRIs.
 - Four key topic areas rising from the input will be discussed in PNAI MWG meetings in August (Main activities and role of PNAI, ways PNAI develops recommendations and insight; The value PNAI brings to international AI fora and high-level AI governance

- dialogues) and in September (Connecting to local AI realities, lifting underrepresented voices especially in the Global South; PNAI as central coordinator hub on AI within the IGF).
- Starting point texts will be shared through PNAI mailing list one week before each meeting, Maikki will prepare these short texts based on survey and other input. All attendees are requested to read the texts before meetings and leave written comments latest the day after.
 - An open consultation will be held in September. Facilitators are preparing ways to gather feedback from specific groups, such as the Chinese or African community, through facilitated small discussions. All suggestions on connecting different communities to the process are welcome. The report will be published in early November 2025.
5. Patrick Bell presented PNAI Key Messages, an active team is working on the newly structured document. The List of International AI Fora matrix has been filled with details on events and groups, more information on PNAI members with connections to or participating in the dialogues is needed. Everyone is welcome to access both documents in Google Docs. **1.9.** was set as joint deadline to finalize both projects.

6. A meeting summary, materials and presentations will be shared through the PNAI mailing list.
7. Deadline for Key Messages and International AI Fora is **1.9.** The working teams will convene as needed.
8. All PNAI members are encouraged to answer the survey by **15.9.** and welcome to share the link with others.
9. Invites for the September PNAI MWG meeting on the first two PNAI Policy Brief topics will be sent out soon. The first starting point text will be circulated through PNAI mailing list one week prior.
