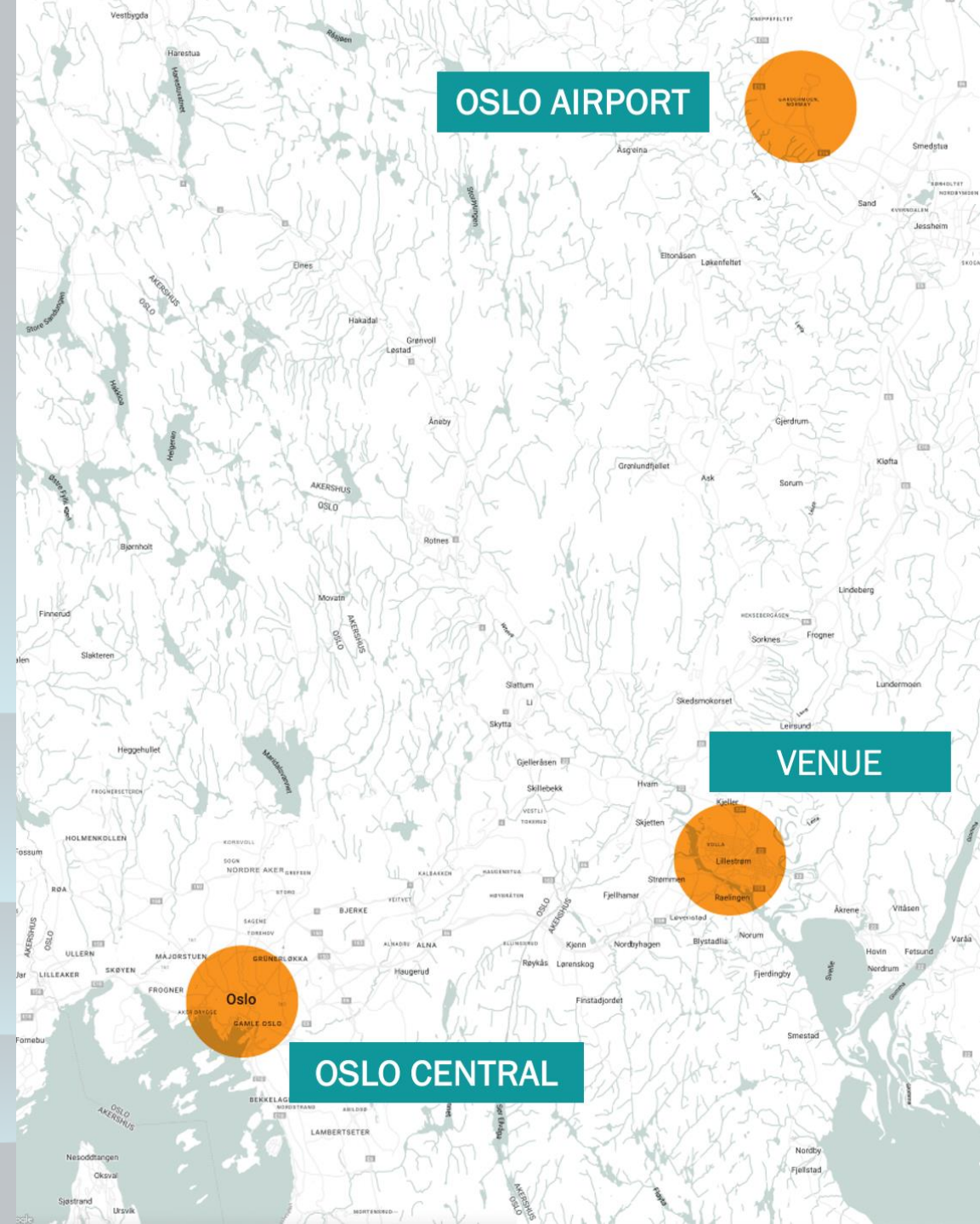
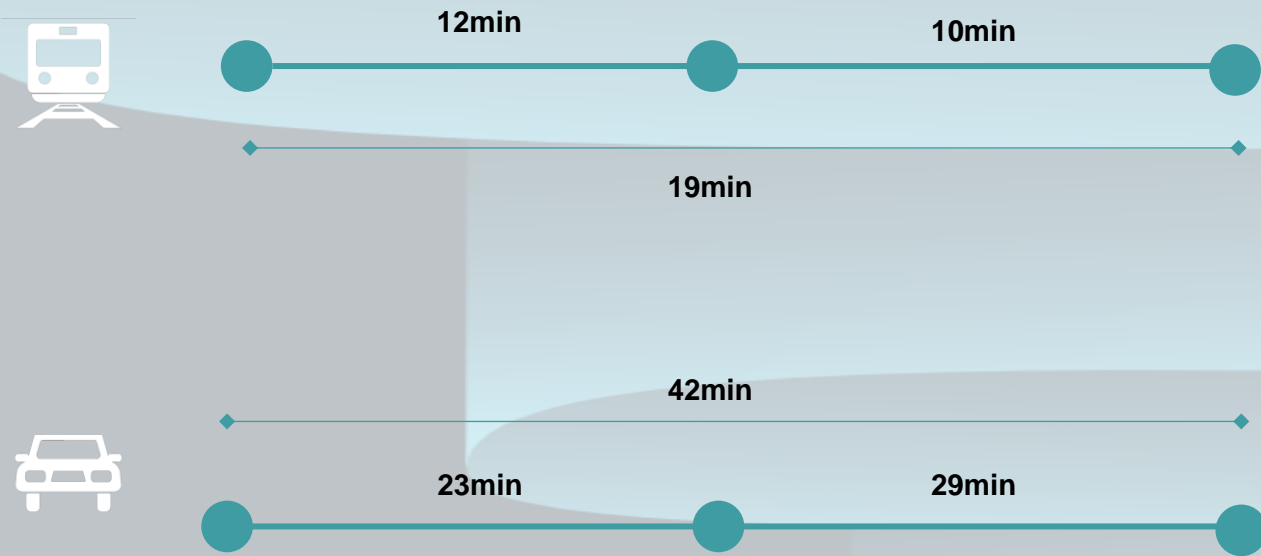

Oslo

- Named the European Green Capital in 2019, Oslo strives to be among the world's greenest cities and a frontrunner in sustainable development.
- On its path to becoming a zero-emission city, Oslo constantly develops new green mobility solutions.
- Priding itself as "the electric vehicle capital of the world", the city boasts the most electric vehicles per capita on the planet.
- Oslo Airport is recognised as exceptionally environmentally-friendly. The airport's most recent terminal is the first ever airport building to receive an "Excellent" BREEAM rating.



Accommodation

- Multiple hotel groups known for their solid sustainability policies are well-represented in Oslo.
- In total, 95% of Oslo's hotels are eco-labelled or certified.
- Participants at IGF Norway 2025 are offered discounted rates at several hotels in Oslo through the host country website.
- Wide range of accommodation, from budget-friendly to high-end hotels.
- Room reservations are subject to availability, and current rates are valid until 25 March.



Oslo Airport - Gardermoen

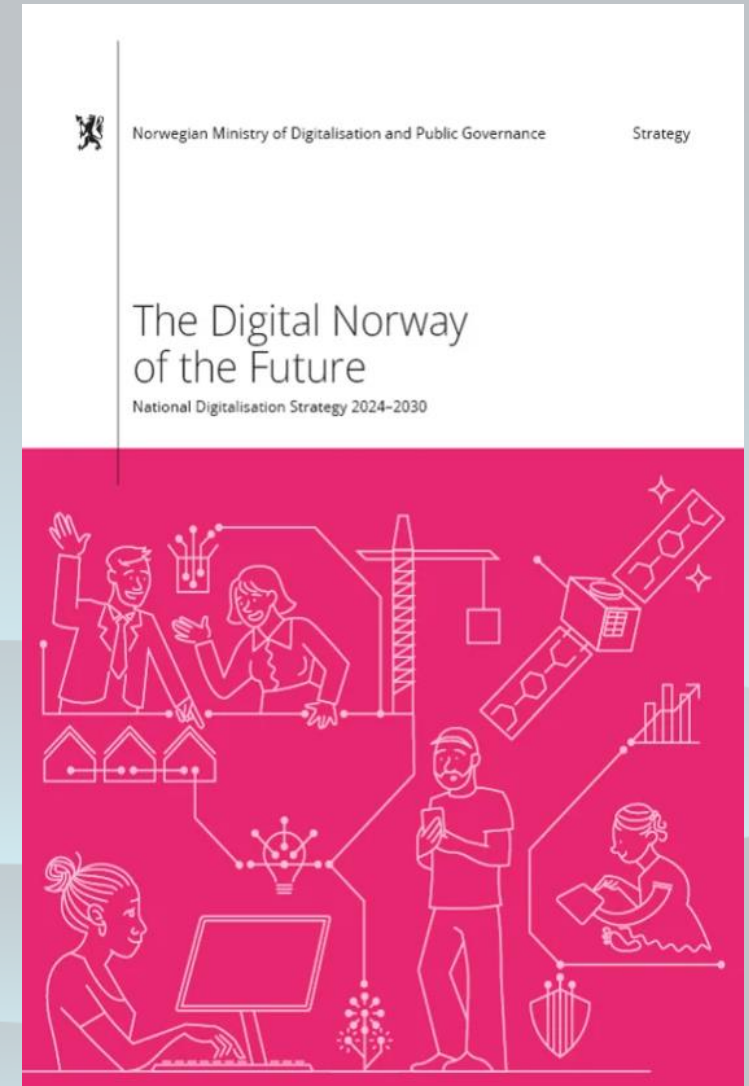
- Direct routes to more than 140 domestic and international destinations, and more than 80 charter destinations.
- Among the most modern in Europe, world-leading on contactless and self-service options such as check-in, bag-drop and boarding.
- Located at Gardermoen, 47 kilometres (29 miles) north of Oslo's city centre.
- Connected to the Oslo region by the Airport Express Train, inter-city and local trains and bus. Taxis, shuttles and limousine services are also available.
- 12 minutes by train from the venue and 20 minutes to Oslo city centre.

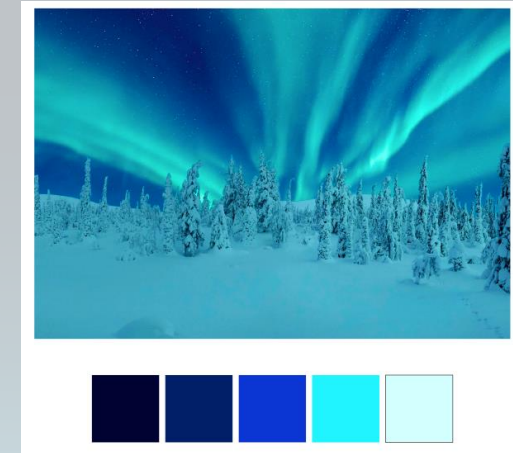

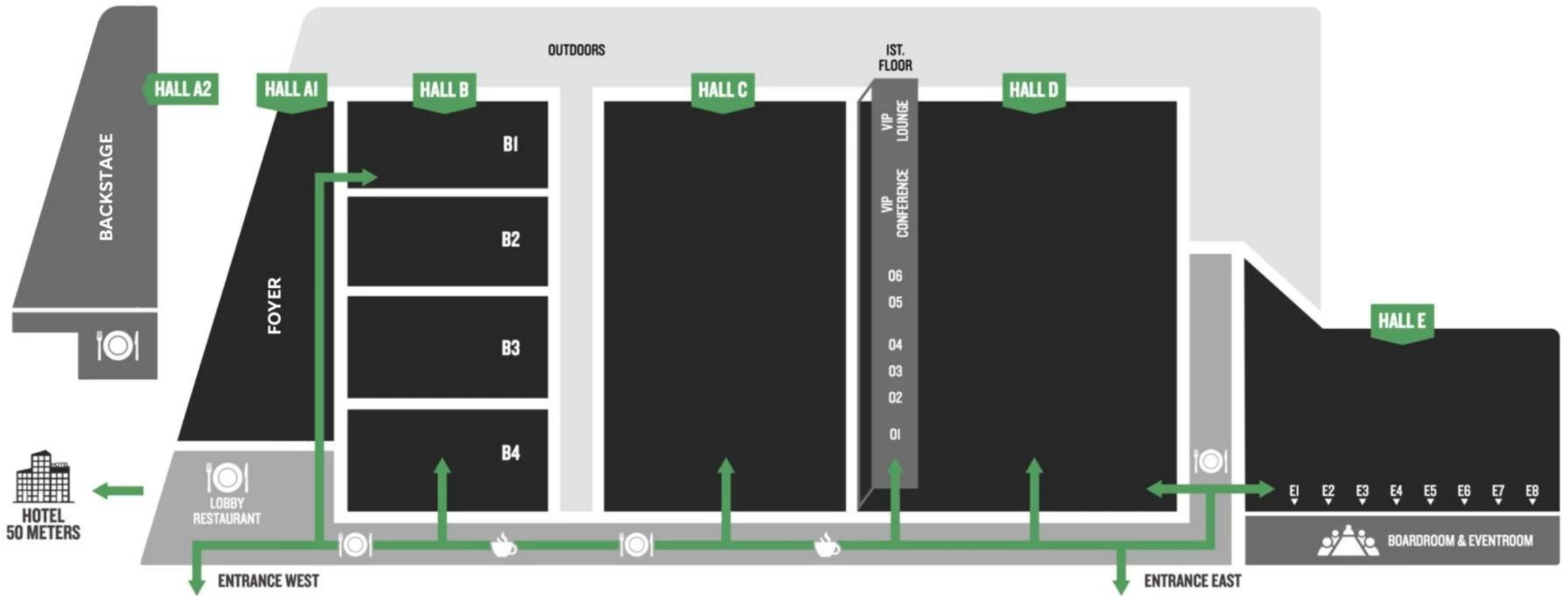


Venue Nova Lillestrøm
