Cultural concept

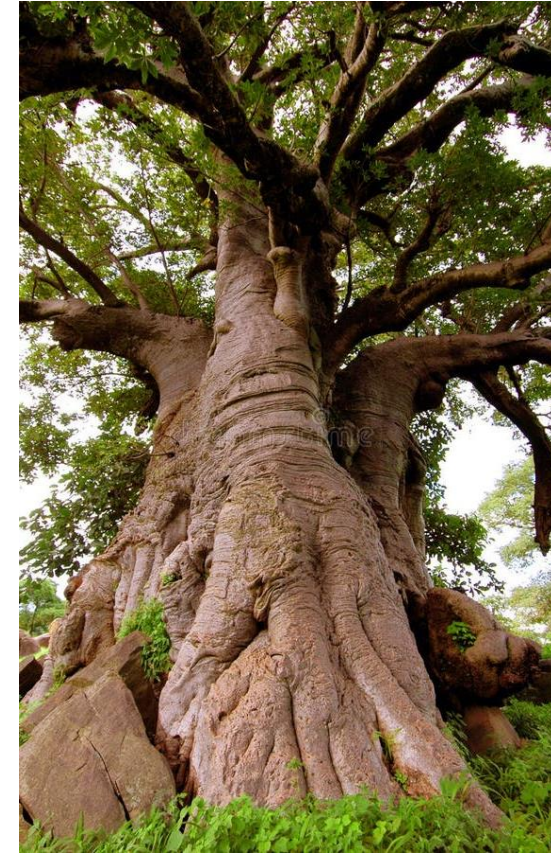
The cultural program will reflect:
