IGF 2024

Dynamic Coalition Coordination Group (DCCG)

Virtual Meeting #87 | 7 August 2024

Summary Report

I. Adoption of the agenda

The agenda of the DCCG meeting #87 was adopted as proposed and is available in Annex I. The call was co-moderated by the DCCG co-facilitators Jutta Croll and Markus Kummer. The list of participants is attached as Annex II.

II. Status of IGF 2024 DC Sessions

Key points raised:

- The IGF Secretariat reached out to all DC session proposers asking to collaborate on joint session proposals, considering the limited number of slots on the IGF programme this year.
- DCs were reminded that the IGF Secretariat responds to the stock taking and feedback received from IGF stakeholders last year, requesting a more focused agenda with sessions that start later and end earlier in the day. Reducing the number of sessions on the schedule leads unfortunately to a reduced number of DC sessions, as well. The survey sent to DCs earlier in the year indicated that joint DC sessions would be the preferred alternative to individual DC sessions.
- As of now, 8 joint DC proposals have been submitted or are being worked on. Another 10 Dynamic Coalitions need to come back to the Secretariat with joint proposals.
- The IGF Secretariat took note of the dissatisfaction of several DCs to collaborate on joint proposals and will keep the MAG informed at their upcoming virtual meeting. DCs fear to have less exposure to potential new DC members, as well as to receive less input from IGF participants.
- The IGF Secretariat will also propose to the MAG to meet at the IGF 2024 in Riyadh and discuss a way forward to enhance the integration of DCs at future IGFs.
- Apart from joint DC sessions, Dynamic Coalitions that are interested in holding an annual DC meeting at the IGF should reach out to the Secretariat to book a hybrid meeting room slot (latest by 1 October). Dynamic Coalitions would have to prepare independently a virtual link in case they would like to hold a hybrid meeting. The room is technically equipped to allow for virtual participation.
- DCs agreed that DC sessions that are on the IGF programme should be of substantive nature and that annual DC meetings should rather be held in separate meeting rooms.
- Key takeaways and reports of DC sessions should be uploaded on the various DC session pages, as key takeaways contribute to the drafting of the IGF key messages.
- It was mentioned that outcomes of joint DC sessions should be publicized effectively. Besides publishing DC session summaries on the individual DC pages, DC key takeaways should also be included in the IGF summary report under the *IGF intersessional work* section.
- It was proposed to create a session to allow reporting the key takeaways of all intersessional work, including DC sessions either after the stock taking session or before the open mic session on the last day of the Forum. Another suggestion was to hold such a session in conjunction with the first MAG meeting/open consultation of the following cycle, as this would allow for a more thorough preparation of the substantive reporting of the outcomes.

• It was suggested to organize a separate DC event prior to the IGF, such as on Day 0. This would be an opportunity for DCs to exchange best practices on funding, visibility, and on how to better integrate in the IGF system. There used to be a DC stock taking session, which could be revived at the IGF in Riyadh.

Next steps

- The IGF Secretariat will reach out by the end of the week to the DCs reminding them to submit joint proposals. All joint proposals should be submitted to the IGF Secretariat by end of August.
- > The IGF Secretariat will inform all other IGF session organizer by next week, releasing the draft IGF schedule.
- > Meeting room requests for DCs to hold an annual meeting alongside the IGF should reach out to the IGF Secretariat as soon as possible and no later than 1 October.

III. IGF 2024 DC main session proposal

Key points raised:

- As agreed during the DCCG meeting #86, the IGF Secretariat prepared a <u>survey for DCs</u> to indicate the reports and/or research projects that they are working on in 2024 and 2025, as well as to indicate the preferred overarching topic to support with the preparation of the DC main session proposal.
- The IGF Secretariat also shared a <u>DC main session working document</u>.
- DCs agreed to construct a main session agenda that focuses on the Global Digital Compact (GDC) with a thread on sustainable development, as the GDC covers nearly all Dynamic Coalitions.
- The IGF Secretariat will update the DC survey, asking DCs to select the GDC objectives that fit them the most.

Next steps

- The DCs are kindly asked to respond to the <u>survey</u> by 14 August to inform the IGF Secretariat and the IGF MAG about their reports and/or research projects that they are working on in 2024 and 2025 (if any), as well as to indicate the GDC objective that is the most relevant to their work.
- > The IGF Secretariat will work on a DC main session description based on today's discussions and share with DCs for their review and input by 16 August.
- > The IGF Secretariat will submit the DC proposals on 19 August, prior to the MAG meeting on 20 August.

IV. Any other business

Key points raised:

- The IGF Secretariat will request the MAG to nominate a DC liaison at the upcoming virtual MAG meeting on 20 August.
- The IGF Secretariat will send out a Doodle Poll to schedule the next DCCG meeting.
