Dynamic Coalition Coordination Group (DCCG)

Virtual Meeting #90 | 4 November 2024

Summary Report

The participants of the Dynamic Coalition Coordination Group (DCCG) Meeting #90 focused on the IGF 2024 DC Main Session and core team's efforts for preparation of content and speakers. They also discussed the creation of a brochure for the DCs booth at the upcoming event. The meeting covered the booth representation schedule and the need for a coordinator. The team discussed the relationship between Dynamic Coalitions and the MAG, whether there is a common understanding of the group's role, and the importance of showcasing their contributions to the IGF community.

I. Adoption of the draft agenda

The agenda of the DCCG meeting #90 was adopted as proposed and is available in Annex I. The call was co-moderated by the DCCG co-facilitators Jutta Croll and Markus Kummer. The list of participants is attached as Annex II.

II. IGF 2024 DC Main Session

The co-moderator shared the results of the core team's efforts to shape the [DC Main Session at the IGF](#) focusing on the title 'contributing to the Global Digital Compact (GDC)' and the role of the DCs. She also mentioned a table prepared by Joao, which sorts Dynamic Coalitions to the 5 key objectives of the GDC. The conversation ended with an open floor for questions and comments. The work is to be continued in these 5 working groups on each GDC theme after the DCCG Meeting.

III. Meeting with the MAG at the IGF 2024

The co-moderator suggested that the 2021 DCs Research paper could serve as a basis for the meeting. However, some participants felt that the 2021 paper had been overtaken by events and should instead focus on the GDC implementation. The paper produced by the IGF Strategy Group could also be used as a starting point. The group also suggested that the agenda for the meeting with the MAG should be proposed by the DCs. The point was made that it will be important for the DCs to make a good impression on the MAG.

IV. Joint DC IGF Village Booth and DC brochure

The DCCG discussed the creation of a brochure for the Dynamic Coalition (DC) booth at the upcoming event. The brochure, to be prepared by the IGF Secretariat by the next DCCG Meeting, would provide a concise overview of DC's work and activities, with QR codes for easy access to their documents and activities. There will be also a document created by the IGF Secretariat to allocate slots among the DCs to volunteer at the booth.

V. Any other business

The DCCG discussed two drafting exercises by the MAG Working Group on Strategy and Strengthening of the IGF. The first was the IGF Vision paper, which contemplated reviewing intersessional models of activity of the IGF, including the DCs. The second was a draft letter to the co-facilitators of the UN WSIS+20 review, pledging the IGF community's support and participation in the review process. The question was raised about coordinating a DCs group response into these drafting exercises. It was suggested that individual DCs should comment individually on both documents, as drafting a collective response might be too time consuming and could result in a less impactful outcome, as it would have to be based on the smallest common denominator.

Next Steps

- DCCG to ask the IGF Secretariat to set up smaller mailing lists for the organization of the DC groups for the Main Session preparation.
- IGF Secretariat to check on the possibility of DC presentations at the village stage and provide an update at the next meeting.
- IGF Secretariat to prepare a brochure of all DCs collectively for the booth by the next meeting.
- IGF Secretariat to create a document for DCs to fill in volunteer time slots for the booth.
- Co-facilitators to send out an email to the DC list with the named coordinators for each bucket and call DCs to action to organize themselves among their respective group.
- DCs to decide on their coordinator and on their speaker for each bucket within one week.
- DCs to prepare short papers (0.5 page) on their main contributions towards the GDC objectives for the main session.
- DC Coordination Group to propose the agenda for the meeting with the MAG and discuss it in the next meeting.
