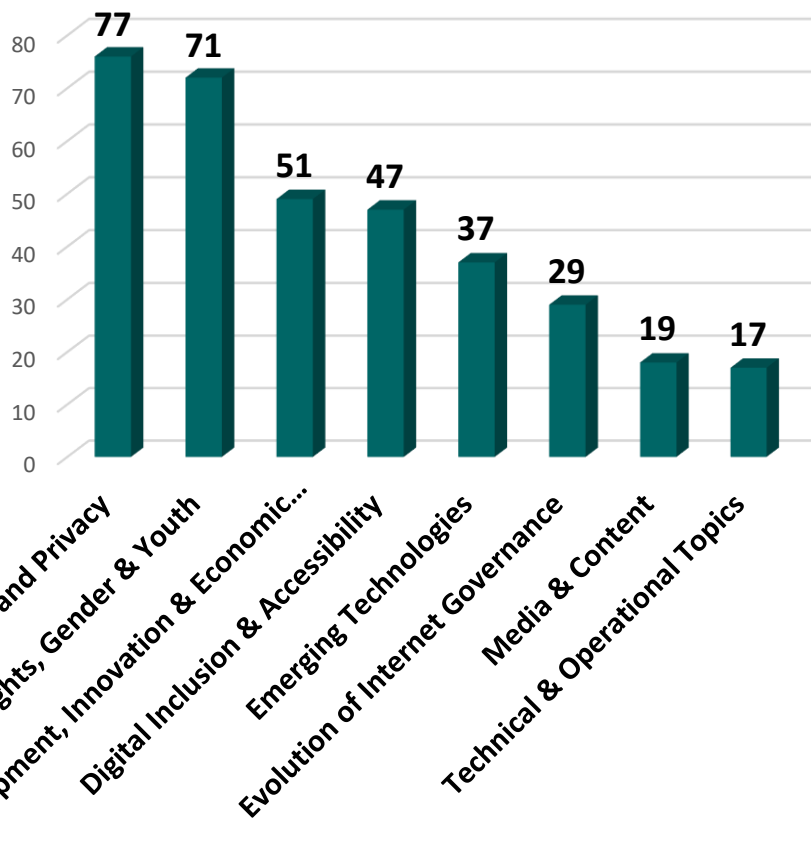

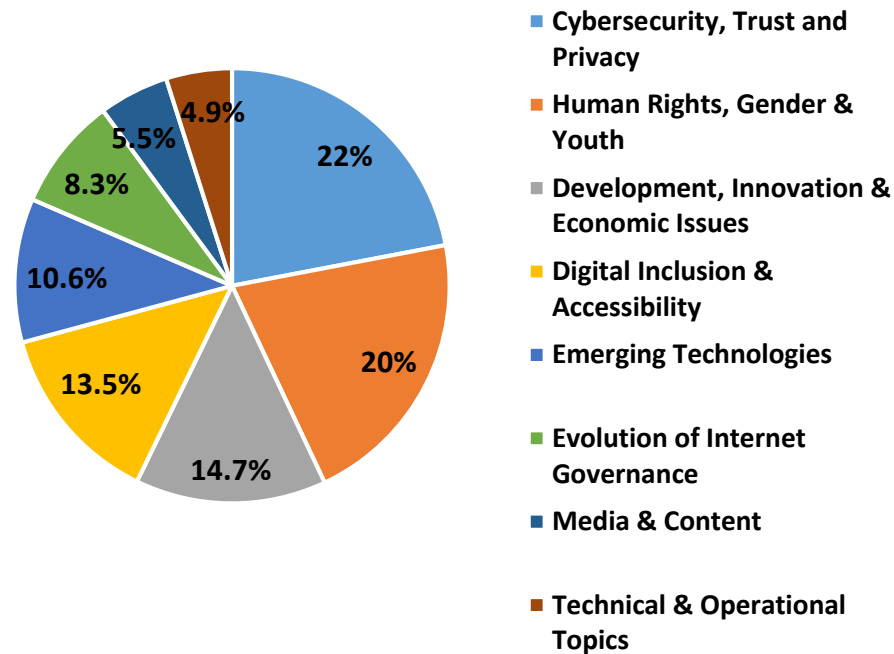

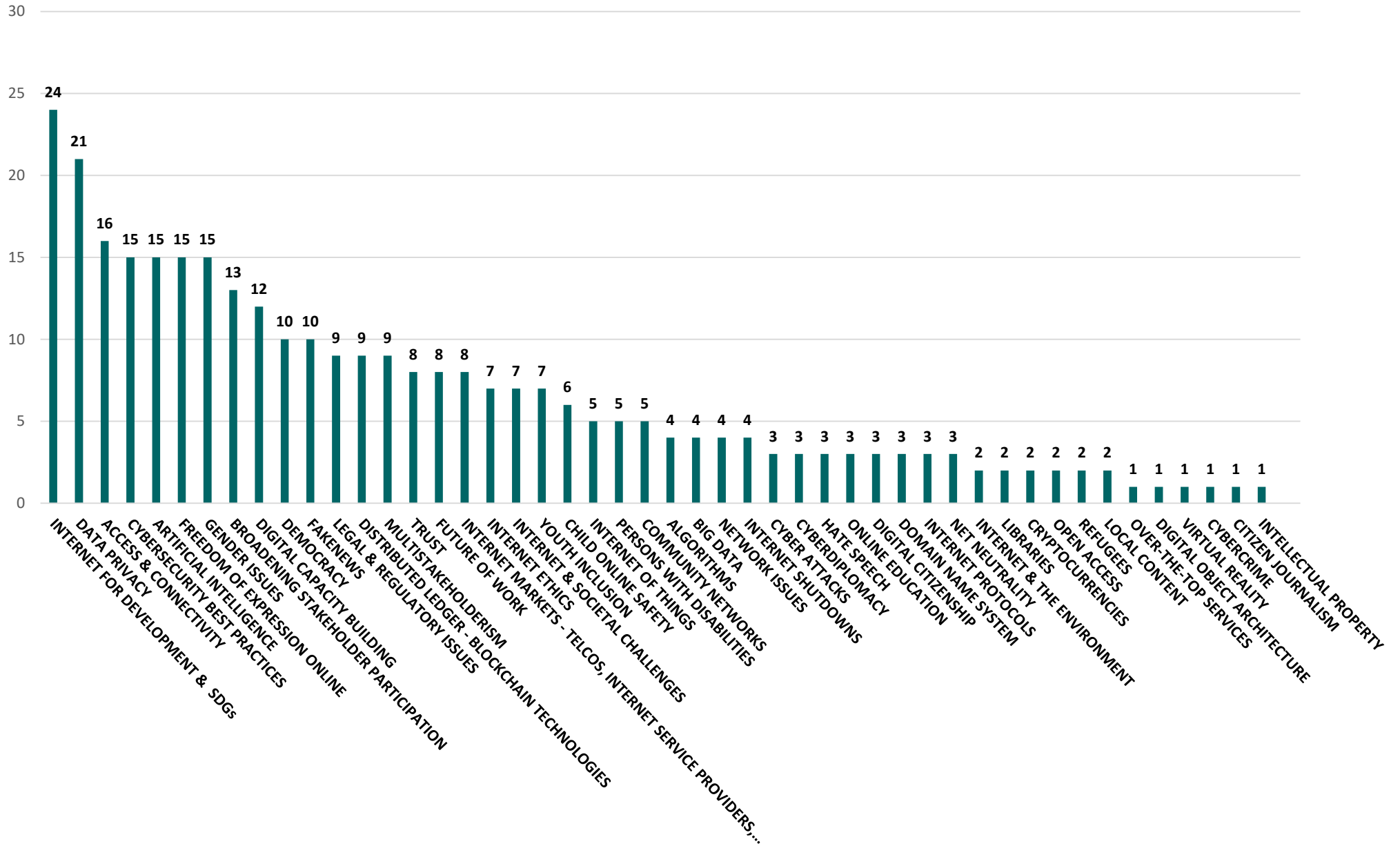
Themes in Descending Order



Theme Proportions

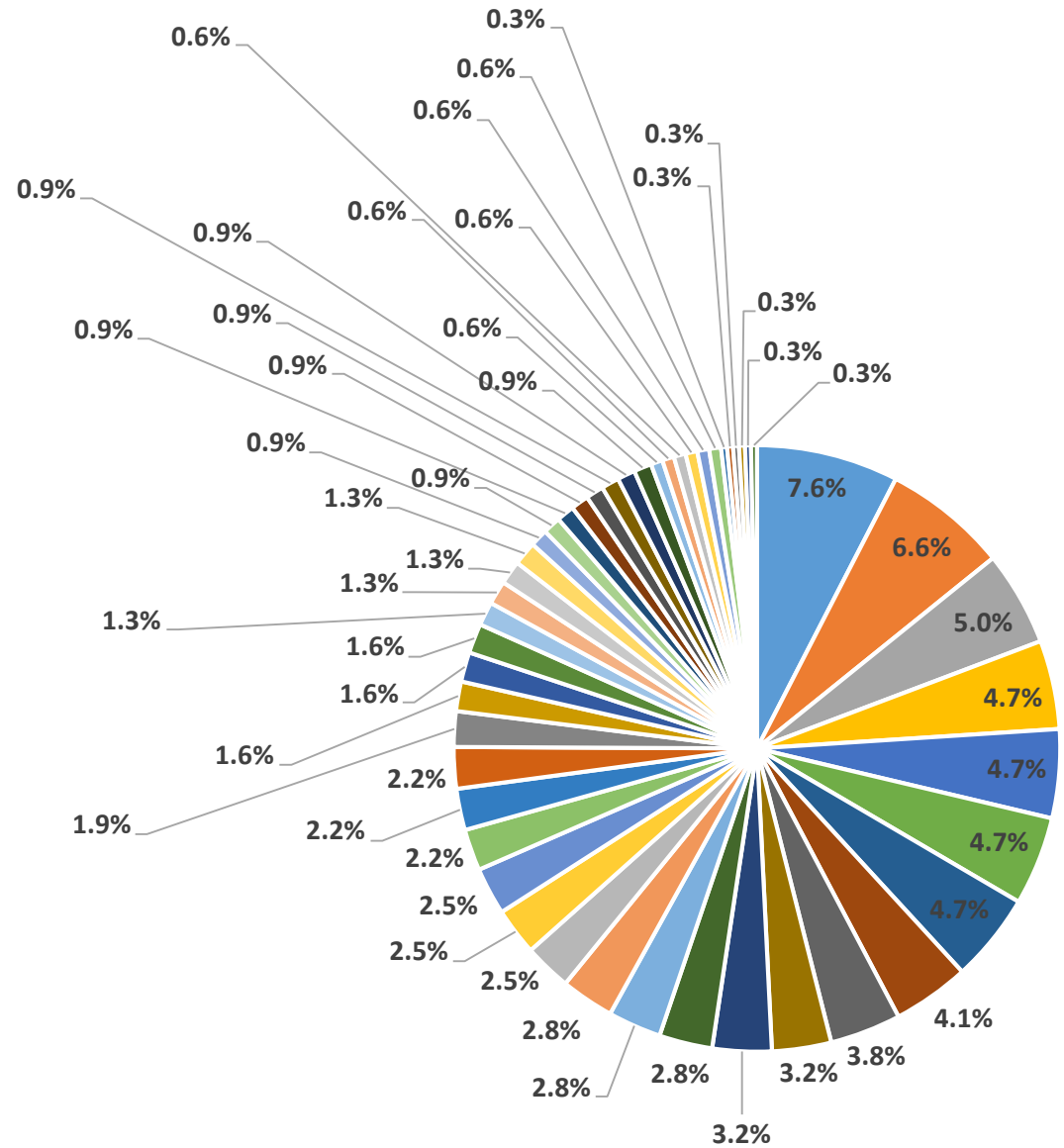

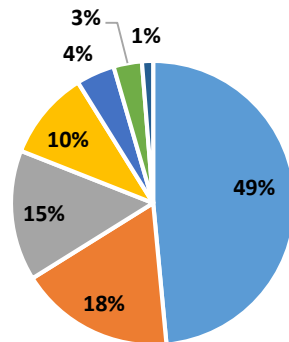


Co-organizers by Gender (unique)



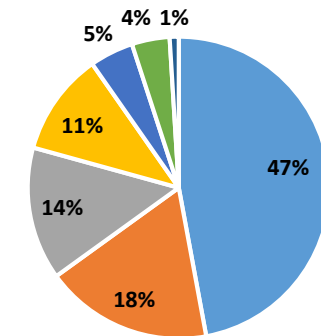

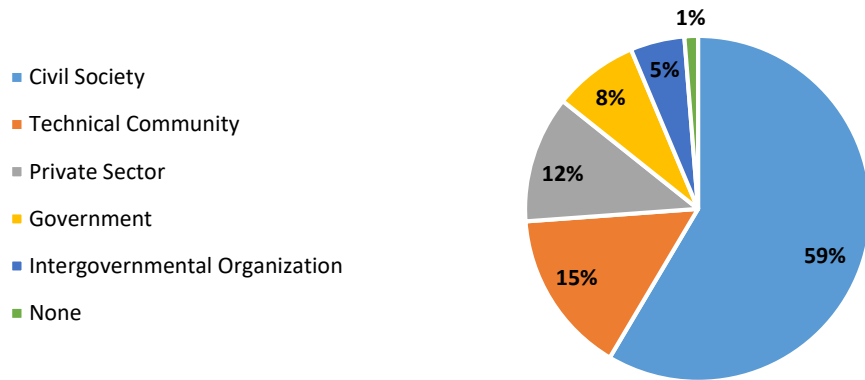

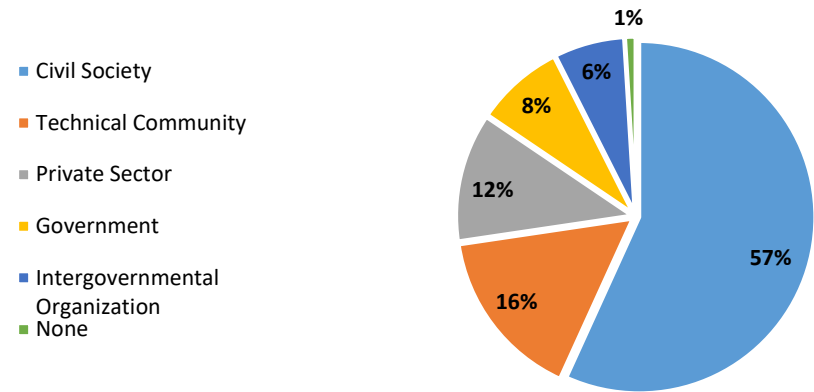

**Co-Organizers by Stakeholder Group (on all proposals)**

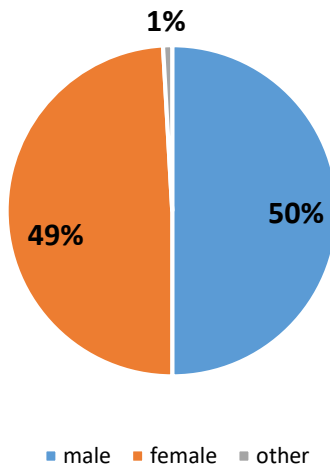


**Co-Organizers by Stakeholder Group (unique)**

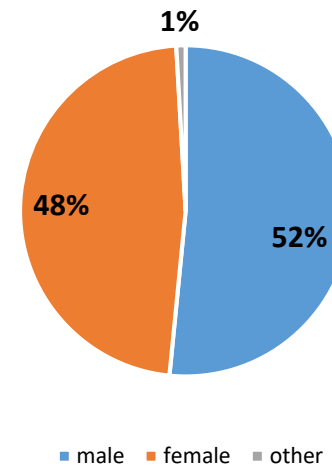
