Perfect location near the intersection of major highways

The proximity of three international airports:

- Katowice Pyrzowice (30 km)
- Kraków-Balice (70 km)
- Ostrava (135 km)

Railway connections:

- 2,5 h from Warsaw
- 4,5 h from Vienna
- 5 h from Prague

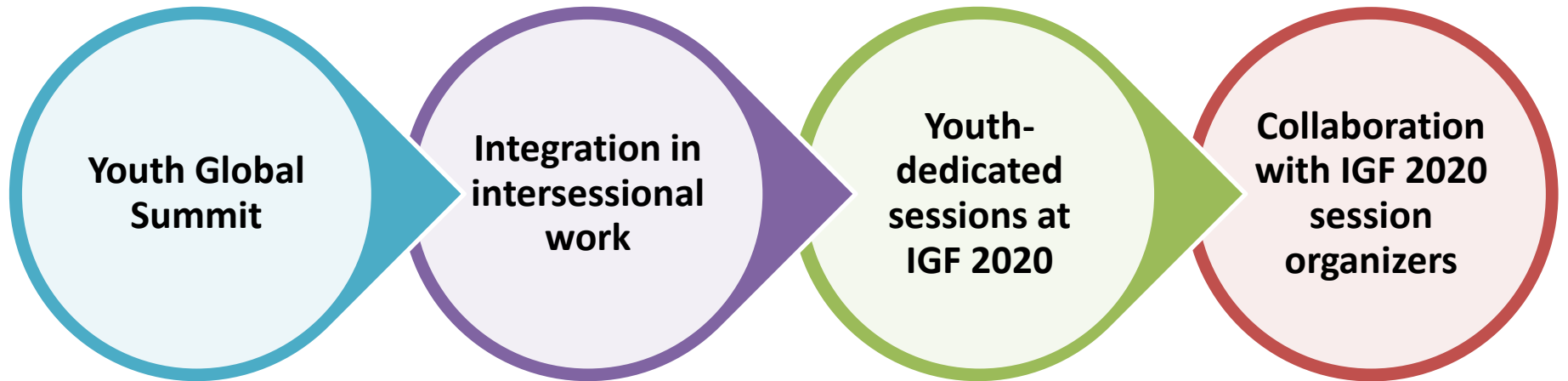
- **EXPECT**

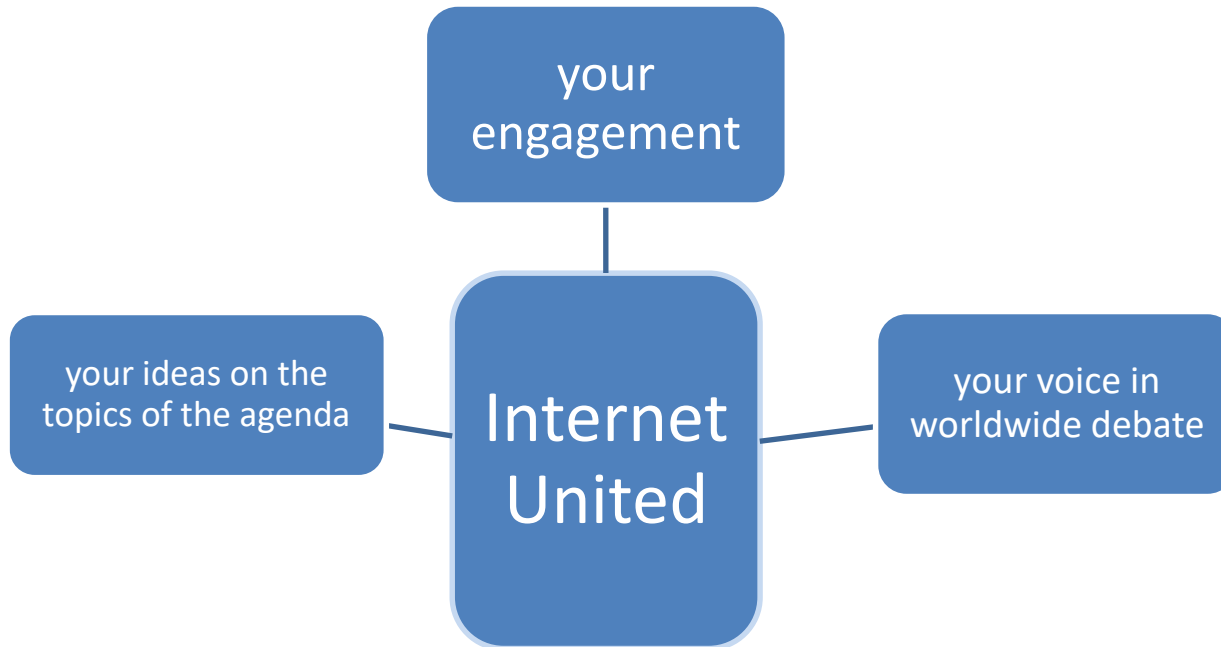



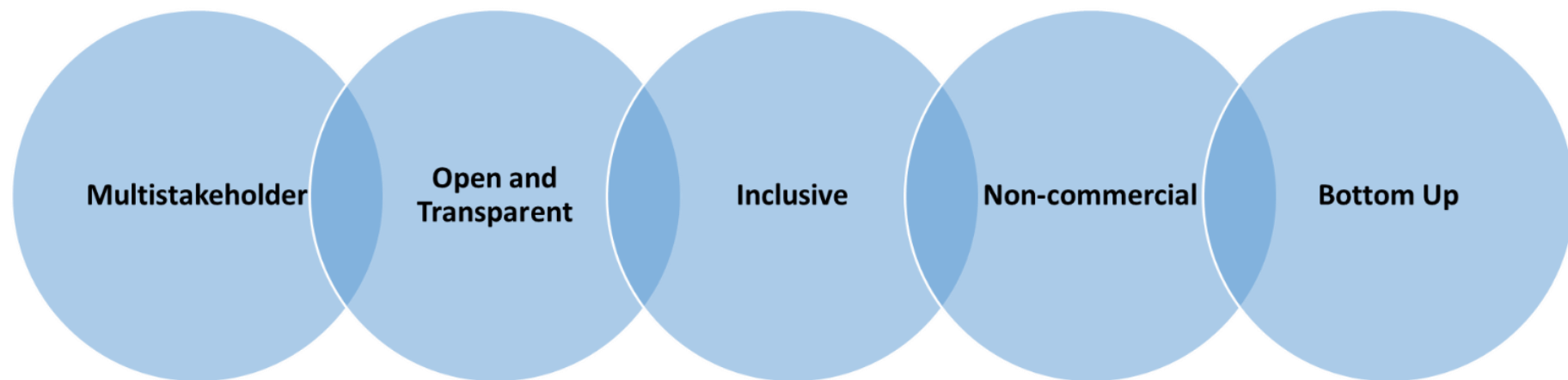
