

INTERNET GOVERNANCE FORUM 2025 NATIONAL, (SUB)REGIONAL AND YOUTH IGF INITIATIVES

- Virtual Meeting II -

27 February 2025 at 15:00 UTC

SUMMARY REPORT

Action Items:

- IGF Secretariat to send a survey to the NRIs list to determine topic prioritization and session type (main or collaborative). NRIs to respond by 9 March end of day UTC.
- 1. The second virtual meeting of the NRIs in the IGF 2025 preparatory cycle took place on 27 February 2025 at 15:00 UTC. The meeting was hosted by the IGF Secretariat's NRIs Focal Point. The final adopted version of the Agenda is attached as Annex A1, the list of meeting participants as Annex A2, and the list of meeting inputs as Annex A3.
- 2. The meeting was convened to decide on the topics of the NRIs sessions at the 20th annual IGF meeting in Norway.

Summary of points

- 3. Participants were presented with an overview of the results of consultations among all NRIs on topics of interest that could be the focus of NRIs sessions at the 20th annual IGF meeting in Norway.
- 4. The network reviewed the consultation results holistically, not limiting the discussion to only the highest-ranked themes. Issues that received over ten endorsements were examined more closely, and in some cases, merging related topics was suggested. The following thematic issues were prioritized:
 - Local connectivity and community-based networks and solutions for affordance universal access. *This topic could be combined with capacity building.*
 - Managing cybersecurity threats.
 - Child online safety.
 - Strengthening multistakeholder approach to Internet governance (*taking into account important processes such as NetMundial, GDC, WSIS+20, SDGs 2030 etc.*).
 - Data governance: ensuring transparency, protection and responsible use of personal and organizational data. *This could be also looked in the context of AI.*
- 5. It was agreed that all sessions should be aligned with the WSIS+20 review and GDC implementation. This requires linking the topics to relevant WSIS action lines and GDC objectives while ensuring that discussions reflect the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development.
- 6. The IGF Secretariat informed participants that NRIs collaborative sessions may be reduced to 60 minutes due to a limited number of session slots and rooms at IGF 2025. This necessitates a



more issue-focused approach with an efficient session format.

- 7. To develop the sessions, working groups will be formed for each topic, with designated leaders to facilitate discussions. The working groups will be responsible for integrating policy questions and relevant issues into each thematic session.
- 8. Given that five priority themes must fit into four sessions, it was agreed that a survey would be sent to the NRIs list to determine which topics should be prioritized. The survey will also gather preferences on whether each topic should be structured as a main or collaborative session.
- 9. Proposed Timeline:
 - Respond to the survey: 9 March.
 - Final endorsement of its results: 12 March.
 - Form 4 working groups: by 17 March.
 - Each group to finalize the proposal: 4 April.
 - Proposals uploaded to the IGF website: 5 April.
- 10. In light of the extended consultation phase, it was agreed that the three NRIs that had requested an extension to respond to the initial consultations may submit their inputs during this phase.
- 11. The IGF 2024 Host Country proposed the idea of having an "NRI Day" during the 20th IGF in Norway, where all NRI sessions would be scheduled on the same day. Some participants expressed reservations about this proposal, while others were open to exploring the idea further. The Secretariat was asked to provide more details once additional information is received from the Host Country. As soon as this information becomes available, it will be shared via the NRIs mailing list.
- 12. Participants also discussed the NRIs response to the WSIS+20 consultations. They were encouraged to review the email from the North African IGF community member proposing a way forward. Meanwhile, the Secretariat will share updates on the timeline for defining WSIS+20 modalities, after consultations with UN DESA, Kenya, and Lithuania, as part of the WSIS secretariat process.

Next Steps

- 13. The IGF Secretariat will circulate the action points for final endorsement on the NRIs mailing list.
- 14. A survey on the topics will be disseminated 24 hours after this meeting.
- 15. A doodle poll will be sent for scheduling a call in the second half of March.
