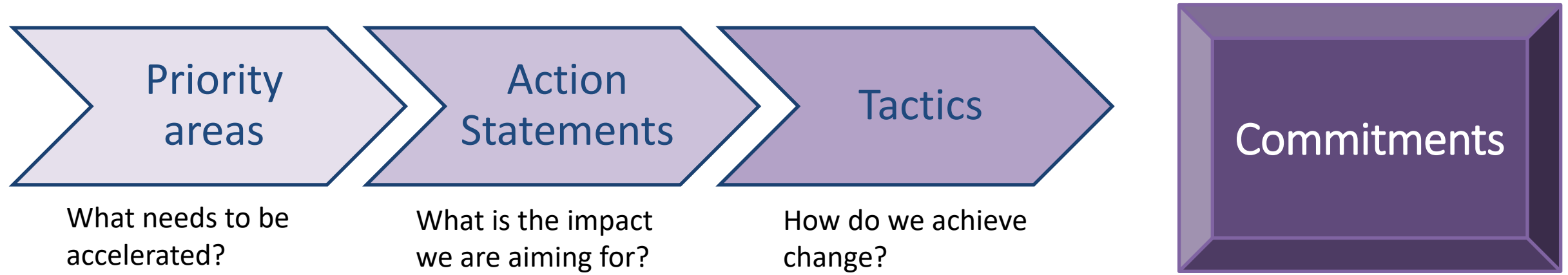
VISION

INVEST IN FEMINIST TECHNOLOGY AND INNOVATION

By 2026, **increase investments** towards feminist technology and innovation by 50% to support women's leadership as innovators and **better respond to women' and girls' most pressing needs**



EMBED GENDER IN TECH DEVELOPMENT

Service Delivery

- Amplify mission driven, grassroots and systemic innovations **making tech accessible, usable and sustainable for all women and girls**



ADOPT FEMINIST TECH-DEVELOPMENT POLICIES

Laws & Policy

- Adopt policies **mitigating risks**, mainstreaming **gender by design** and fostering **knowledge exchange**



MAKE DATA ANALYTICS INCLUSIVE & ACCOUNTABLE

Data & Accountability

- Systematize **gender impact assessments**, **AI audits**, high quality data for **evidence-based solutions**

How to do it ?



BUILD INCLUSIVE, TRANSFORMATIVE & ACCOUNTABLE INNOVATION ECOSYSTEMS

By 2026, double the proportion of women working in technology and innovation by setting up new networks and benchmarks to transform innovation ecosystems



CREATE GENDER-TRANSFORMATIVE INNOVATION HUBS

Service Delivery

- Finance local, regional and feminist networks within digital/ innovation hubs
- Facilitate access to role models and mentors



BOOST WOMEN AND GIRLS' PARTICIPATION AND LEADERSHIP

Laws & Policy

- Mainstream gender in digital public policies
- Commit to parity in workforce
- increase women's participation in digital cooperation

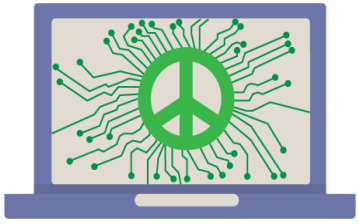


TRANSFORM METRICS FOR DIGITAL INCLUSION

How to do it ?



PREVENT AND ELIMINATE ONLINE & TECH-FACILITATED GBV AND DISCRIMINATION

By 2026, a majority of countries and tech companies demonstrate accountability by implementing policies and solutions against online and tech facilitated GBV & discrimination



ADOPT TOOLS TO BETTER PREVENT AND RESPOND

Service Delivery

- Publicly share reports on spread of online GBV
- Improve tools that avoid harm and user care services



ENHANCE LEGISLATION AND LAW ENFORCEMENT

Laws & Policy

- Adopt adequate legislation
- Train and fund law enforcement
- Fund support to victims and monitoring



DEMONSTRATE ONLINE CULTURAL CHANGE

Social Norms

- Organize global campaigns and develop counter speech
- Sensitize young people, care-givers and educators to prevent, handle and protect

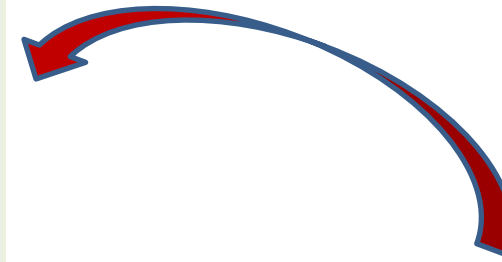

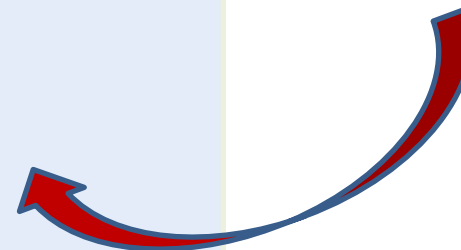
