\text { was brought about due to the 2nd area of action of the partnership: } \\
\text { Skills. During this discussion panelists discussed existing initiatives } \\
\text { and trends that were taking place in the area of STEM studies, as } \\
\text { they relate to women. } \\
\text { Governments do necessarily have a role in the overall discussion and } \\
\text { need to adopt policies and strategies which ensure gender balance } \\
\text { and digital inclusion. }\end{array}

$\left.\begin{array}{|l|l|}\hline & \begin{array}{l}\text { The third big aspect focused on the several opportunities that ICTs } \\ \text { offer to women entrepreneurs that want to start and grow } \\ \text { businesses. In this regards, it was highlighted how many women } \\ \text { entrepreneurs, particularly in developing countries, face a number of } \\ \text { barriers such as institutional, systemic, and customary and cultural } \\ \text { practices, beliefs and norms. }\end{array} \\ \text { The final discussion that took place gave a critical analysis of global } \\ \text { partnerships, such as EQUALS, and the benefits of working in global, } \\ \text { multi-stakeholder initiatives to tackle such complex areas of focus, } \\ \text { such as the gender digital divide. This conversation was led by the } \\ \text { Web Foundation, and pointed out the potential benefits such as } \\ \text { inclusivity of all players and coordinated efforts on a scale not } \\ \text { achievable by single entities. }\end{array}\right\}$
