Expanded Institutional Participation

The sustainable development goals require the global collaboration of various International Organizations, governmental, non-governmental and private (associations), and participation (in unconditional pubic interest) of private business and non-governmental entities as individual entities and that of independent individuals of commitment and strengths. The WG's Charter, probably for this and other reasons, already envisages the importance of bringing in new collaborators.

Expanded Institutional Participation

The combined strength of the collaborators would enable aspirations to cause the evolving Internet to become more of an ecosystem for global progress in various spheres.

Expanded Institutional Participation

Such collaborations may be with organizations committed to finding solutions to global Internet concerns that the IGF shares, but not with any organization that may be have pursuits narrower than acceptable.

Next Steps:

- Attention by the MAG to this paper on multi year work program.
- A presentation of the approved version of the multiyear work plan to the DCs, BPFs, NRIs and the broader IGF Community, preferably during a 30 -45 minute session at the Paris IGF
- Improvements to the MWP incorporating comments / recommendations from the session, and by written comments received during a 4 week period
- Adoption of the final version of the Multi-year work plan by the MAG.F
 2020 and the IGFs of the following years.

Next Steps

- Action items pertaining to DCs / BPFs / NRIs to be initiated.
- Where required, expanded organizational participation to be invited by letters from the MAG Chair to the heads of Organizations / Governments
- Multi Year Work Plan to be in full view during preparation and organization of IGF 2020 and thereafter.
